The worker will support parents with their engagement, capacity building and leadership; with the ultimate aim of enhancing baby and toddler early years development, socialisation and learning up to their school going age. The worker will be part of a dynamic *Family Matters* Team, which is composed of Speech and Language Therapists, Early Years and Education workers and Home Visitors.
