The successful candidate will have a clear understanding of supporting individuals, families and communities experiencing disadvantage and marginalisation to improve their educational outcomes through the provision of supports in home, school, and community settings.

The successful candidate will have a relevant third level qualification combined with a passion for lifelong learning and will have a broad understanding of the range of issues which can impact on educational attainment, particularly in communities facing difficult socio-economic circumstances.
